

Bull Hill Guest Ranch

FACT SHEET

50,000-acre, 106-year-old Bull Hill Guest Ranch is dramatically situated in the foothills of the majestic Rocky Mountains near the Washington State-B.C., Canada border. The ranch spans an area between the north tip of Lake Roosevelt (Columbia River) to the border. Bull Hill is a six-hour drive from Seattle and two hours north of Spokane. It is also accessible by small private aircraft, as the ranch has its own airstrip.

Bull Hill was founded in 1903 by Peter Ansaldo (great-grandfather of owners Don and Pete Guglielmino) as part of the Homestead Act. Originally 160 acres, the working ranch now includes both owned and leased land, which supports a 1,000-head herd of cattle, and more than 70 horses.

Accommodations:

Seven, two-story ranch cabins and two executive-style luxury cabins. Each spacious cabin includes wood burning stoves, hand crafted lodge pole beds, baths with showers and heating fans, alarm clock radios, coffee makers, storage closets and front porches—all located in private settings against a backdrop of cedars, cottonwoods and aspens. The guest ranch also features two large hot tubs and jetted spas.

The two executive-style cabins each contain three bedrooms, two full baths, kitchenette, laundry room and propane-gas stoves. Hardwood floors, carpeting, upgraded beds/linens and leather upholstered furnishings complete the western décor.

Guest services and special ranch features:

- **Half day to full day authentic cattle drive** opportunities (May-October).
- **Guided trail riding** through open meadows and forests and along creeks and the Columbia River/Lake Roosevelt. 50-55 horses of various breeds (April through October).
- **Ansaldo Lake**—privately-owned by the Guglielmino brothers and reserved exclusively for Bull Hill guests—this 20-acre lake features natural spring fed waters stocked with

Kamloops rainbow trout. Great for fishing, boating and swimming. Strictly catch-and-release fly-fishing for the avid outdoor sportsman.

- **Fishing**, snowmobiling and cross-country skiing (Late December thru February), guided hunting for whitetail deer and turkey, hiking, trap shooting and wildlife watching.
- **Private 2,400-foot airstrip** for smaller private planes and aircraft. Call for coordinates.
- **The Cookhouse** features a central meeting place for meals, bar service and entertainment. **The Shower House** features two large bath/showers for guests using the hot tubs and a laundry facility for guest use.
- **7,500-square-foot Horse Barn**, featuring vaulted ceilings and a wraparound interior balcony, can be adapted for special events such as weddings, dances and large corporate parties.

Area Highlights:

- **China Bend Winery** – Located on the shores of the Columbia River, guests can ride their horses to the winery and visit the tasting room.
- **Red Mountain** – A 45 minute drive from Bull Hill, Red Mountain Ski Resort is one of British Columbia’s most challenging and up and coming downhill ski areas.
- **Crown Creek Saloon**—Only accessible to Bull Hill Guests, and one of the “rides” of a lifetime.
- Visits to the **PRCA Colville Rodeo** and **Northport International Stock Car Races** (additional charge).

Rates: All rates are based per person, per day. Accommodations, meals, beverages and ranch activities are packaged as **all-inclusive** unless otherwise stated.

Founded: The guest ranch was founded in 1994 and opened for business one year later. Expansions were completed between 1998 and 2003, with additions made in 2004 and 2009.

Ownership: Brothers Don and Pete Guglielmino and their wives Patty and Patsy are the owners/operators.
